MATCHDAY USAGE, GUIDANCE AND RULES FOR WORTHING CC

Worthing CC expects all of its members, guests, players, and spectators to fully comply with all ECB and UK Government guidelines relating to COVID-19.

These can be found using the below links but Worthing CC would particularly like to remind anyone who is showing symptoms of COVID-19, or that has returned from a country not exempt from the UK Government's global advice against non-essential travel or has otherwise been asked to self-isolate not to travel to Worthing CC.

If you or any member of your family display symptoms of Covid-19, please stay at home and inform WCC Welfare officer – amanda.wheeler@worthingcc.com or 07745 210 154.

In addition, Worthing CC requires all members, guests, players, and spectators to adhere to the following guidelines.

- 1. Preparation:** Prior to all matches, visiting sides must prepare a team card (either hard copy or electronically) and provide to their Worthing CC match contact. This must include their own players' names, including any officials (including scorer) who will be directly involved in the match. The team card must also include the name and contact number/email address of the key club contact who can be contacted in the event of a need to 'test and trace' as per NHS and Government guidance.
- 2. Car Park:** Upon arrival, if there is insufficient room to park safely, respecting social distancing guidelines, then please park on Georgia Avenue or the other streets adjoining the Manor Ground.
- 3. Arrival:** Upon arrival the Worthing CC match contact will direct all playing visitors to their 'club area' in which they must put their bags and ensure they maintain social distancing as per Government guidelines.
- 4. Player requirements:** All players will be encouraged to arrive at the ground in their whites as all changing facilities will not be available under current guidelines. All players will sanitise their hands upon arrival and regularly throughout the match. When fielding, players must use hand sanitiser during the 'hygiene breaks' (every 6 overs or 20 minutes, whichever is sooner). All players will bring their own food/drink with them. Refilling of water bottles is available from the tap in the kitchen, please ensure you contact a WCC for assistance. Water bottles or other refreshment containers should not be shared. All players will use their own playing kit where possible. If kit is to be shared between players, it must be sanitised between uses. Hand sanitiser is available, but players are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitiser for personal use.
- 5. Pavilion:** The pavilion will be open on match-days for usage of toilets and occasionally to purchase refreshments (see **Bar**). There will be a clearly signed, one-way system in operation and hand sanitiser will be provided upon entry and exit.
- 6. Spectators:** Please bring your own seating (if required) and respect social distancing at all time. If entering the pavilion, please respect the one-way system, use the hand sanitiser provided and sign the visitor's book, providing full name and contact details for NHS Test and Trace purposes. Players, scorers, and match officials do not need to do this as they are included in the team card mentioned above.
- 7. Bar:** The bar will be opened periodically for purchase of refreshments. Please review the detailed instructions that will be displayed upon entry to the pavilion.



8. **Toilets:** When using the toilets, please follow the one-way system in operation when entering the pavilion. Hand sanitiser is provided on entrance and exit.
9. **Match regulation:** Worthing CC will be following Government and ECB guidance; however, all users participate at their own risk. Please remember to bring your own match-ball for use during your fielding innings. All players must also arrive fully changed with their own kit (as changing rooms will remain closed for the time being) and bring their own food and drink.

Thank you for your co-operation in adhering to these guidelines and helping Worthing CC facilitate the safe return of Junior and Senior cricket.
